



EEG TEST

An electroencephalogram (EEG) test measures and records the electrical activity of your brain through electrodes placed on the scalp with a helmet. Once the electrodes are in place, an EEG typically takes around 25 minutes. You relax in a sitting position with your eyes closed during the test. Body motions are captured by a video camera while the EEG records your brain waves. This combined recording can help the Doctor diagnose and treat your condition. The test is noninvasive and useful for diagnosing seizures along with a number of other conditions.
